
CHARACTER


THE IB CONTINUUM




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What is the MYP Certificate?

- The MYP Certificate is awarded based on the performance of external assessment tasks at the end of MYP
- It consists of 8 components
 - 6 online exams
 - 1 ePortfolio
 - 1 Personal Project






When will it take place?

May 2024

Grade 10 Students:

- Complete Personal Project by February, 2024
- Tuesday, May 7th: Language & Literature
- Thursday, May 9th: Mathematics
- Friday, May 7th: IDU




When will it take place?

May 2025

General exam dates for the full Certificate program:

- Registration: October 2025
- Eportfolio and Personal Project: March 2025
- Six E-Assessments: May 2025



How are students marked?

- ePortfolios and Personal Project are marked by teachers and then moderated by IBO trained examiners
 - Online exams are marked externally by IBO trained examiners
 - Results are shared with the school and students in August
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- The maximum total score for the IB MYP certificate is **56**, with a grade from 1-7 assigned to each required component (8).
 - Students must achieve a total of at least **28** points, with a grade of '3' or higher in each E-Assessment component, to be eligible to receive the IB MYP certificate.

What are the implications if a student does not earn the full certificate?

- Option to resit exams that received a 2 or below in November
 - Students still earn MYP course results for components that earned a 3 or above.
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- Exemptions
 - Will inform CP/DP options
 - Equivalency for CP students in the future

How Does This Benefit students?

- The eAssessment is 75% inquiry, communication and critical thinking skills
 - The curriculum and teaching and learning strategies need will reflect these higher order skills throughout the MYP
 - Command terms
 - OECD skills for the future
- Indicators for success at CP/DP level.
- Support applications for post-16 education.

- The secondary school is undergoing some curriculum review beginning with Grades 9 and 10.
- Assessment styles throughout the MYP.
- Timetabling.
- Pilot with current Grade 10.
- Liaising with schools currently utilising the eAssessment
