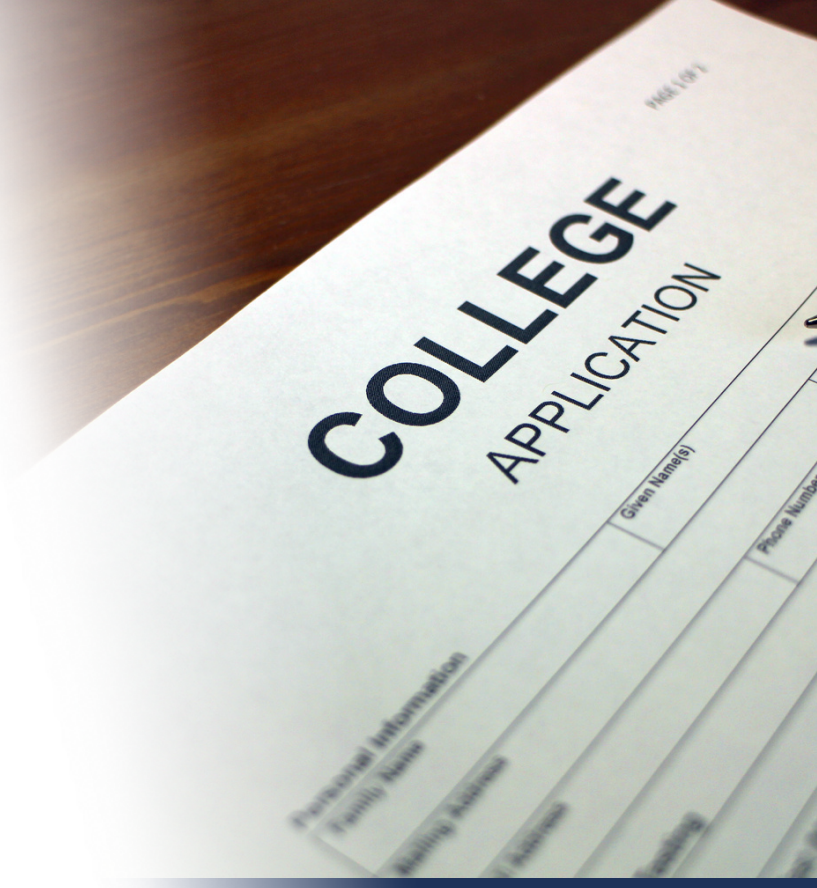

2024 ACT INFORMATION FOR 11TH GRADE STUDENTS & FAMILIES

On February 27th, 2024, Wakulla High School and Wakulla Institute will administer the ACT to all 11th grade students free of charge. The ACT is an entrance exam used by most colleges and universities to make admissions decisions. The purpose of the ACT test is to measure a high school student's readiness for college, and provide colleges with one common data point that can be used to compare all applicants. These scores can also be used to satisfy graduation requirements and qualify for scholarships, including the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship program.
