3/8	The data was received for the Winter Keystones administered to learners that weren't able to achieve proficiency the prior time. Sixty-eight of the 72 learners maintained or improved their first time score. This had an impact on both proficiency level and whether a learner's composite score secured them of accomplishing graduation pathway "two".

Dates	General
March	The Federal Program grant amendment revision window has been opened. The revised numbers will be received shortly and appropriate adjustments will be made. These numbers typically stay fairly consistent. The 2023-24 numbers will be released at the beginning of May.
	We are continuing to collect all the required program and fiscal documentation for our Federal Grant monitoring that occurs every three years.
	The new Home School Education Policy draft was released from PSBA and is presently in legal review. The intent is to be presented in May and then approved in June allowing for any interested home education learners to enroll per PDE guidelines in the approved policy.
