

End of Winter Season Athletic Liaison Report 2/14/2023

Girls Basketball: Girls basketball ended the season with a strong 20-2 record. They finished second in section 4, falling behind Columbia, who beat them twice in the regular season. Due to a second-place finish in the section, the girl's team qualified for the Lancaster Lebanon league playoffs. The girls faced an undefeated Lebanon team last Saturday and lost 42-63. The girls are focused on making a run in the district playoffs that kick off on 2/21/. We will be hosting Brandywine Heights in our gym at 7 PM. A win in the district playoffs would qualify us to participate in the state playoffs. We hope for a long, exciting playoff run for the girl's team.

Boys Basketball: Boys basketball ended the season with a 5-17 record. They finished last place in section 4 and 11th place in district 3. Although the season did not go as well as we had hoped, the team finished on a two-game winning streak with wins against Upper Dauphin and Annville Cleona.

Boys and Girls Wrestling: The boys and girls wrestling team ended their season with one team win last Saturday against Fairfield at a team dual tournament hosted at Pequea Valley. This team has struggled in the win column due to inexperienced wrestlers and low numbers. Our varsity wrestling team finished the season with just five wrestlers. Even though we did not have the numbers needed to complete, coach Rob King did a great job keeping the team dedicated and motivated throughout the season. Senior Zach Hollenbaugh was voted a 1st team all-star for section 3, and senior Jovanni Candelario was voted an honorable mention for section 3. With a strong youth program and good numbers in the junior high program, we hope for some more competitive seasons to come.

Swimming: Aidan (FR) and Ethan (JR) Wanner represented Pequea Valley as independent swimmers 8 swim meets this season. Aidan swam in 6 of the 8 swim meets and qualified for leagues at each of the events. He will be swimming in the 100 butterfly as an 8 seed and 100 backstroke as the 9th seed at the LL meet February 10-11. In addition, he will swim in districts with automatic time qualification in three events.

Ethan participated in 7/8 individual events with league qualifying times in all seven events. He entered the LL league as the 5th seed in the 100 breast stroke, and the 6th seed in the 200 IM. Ethan also has 3 automatic qualifying times for districts. Districts will be held March 3-4.
