

PEQUEA VALLEY SCHOOL BOARD
Reorganization Meeting
December 8, 2022

The annual Reorganization Meeting of the Pequea Valley School Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Ferris in the District Office Board Room. Members present were Bryant Ferris, Freida Huyard, Ben Ingles, Steve Riehl and Casey Rohrer. Christian Brackbill, Mike Hartmann, Fred Hertzler, and Steve Temple were absent. Appointment of Temporary Chairperson, Ben Ingles.

The report of the Nominating Committee was presented by Ben Ingles, who recommended Bryant Ferris for President and Fred Hertzler for Vice President for 2023. Mr. Ingles asked for nominations from the floor for the positions of President and Vice President. Hearing none, a motion was made by Mrs. Huyard and a second by Mr. Riehl, to conclude the nominations.

Mr. Ingles asked for a motion to approve the nominations. On a motion by Mr. Riehl and a second by Mrs. Huyard, Bryant Ferris was elected as President and Fred Hertzler as Vice President of the Board, each for a one-year term.

The meeting was turned over to President Ferris who presented the report of the Nominating Committee recommending Steve Riehl for Treasurer. Mr. Ferris asked for nominations from the floor for the position of Treasurer. Hearing none, a motion was made by Mr. Ingles and a second by Mrs. Huyard to conclude the nominations.

Voting yes: Ferris, Huyard, Ingles, Riehl, and Rohrer; No-0; Absent: Brackbill, Hartmann, Hertzler, and Temple.

Mr. Ferris asked for a motion to approve the nominations. On a motion by Mrs. Rohrer and a second by Mr. Ingles, Steve Riehl was elected Treasurer for a period of December 8, 2022 through May 31, 2023.
