London ISD received a rating of "A" for Superior Achievement under Texas' School FIRST (Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas). London's score is 96 points, which compared to prior year remains the same.

This rating is the highest and demonstrates the quality of London ISD's financial management and reporting system. (Score of 90-100 Points)

Texas Legislature created School FIRST to improve the management of school districts' financial resources. It began in 2001, and has been amended several times with indicators changing in accordance with legislation.
