Offers expertise, experience, certifications, and college credits while in high school



Opportunities for internships, apprenticeships, and jobs!



10 pathways available in all high schools

8 are available through course selection process 2 are available through application (AMP, MFRI)



17 pathways at McDonough & North Point High Schools

Students apply in the fall of 8th grade



6 pathways at Robert D. Stethem Educational Center

Students apply in the fall of 10th grade

## What determines the CTE pathways offered?

- ► Local workforce needs
- Student and community interest
- CTE pathways must be approved by the Maryland State Department of Education
- Space requirements and equipment needs



## What makes CTE pathways so special?

- Directly tied to current workforce needs, trends, and skills
- Each pathway has a Program Advisory Committee (PAC)
- Opportunity to earn industry recognized credentials and/or college credits while in high school
- Opportunity for internships and apprenticeships



# Blueprint for Maryland's Future: Impact on CTE

- All students College and Career Ready by 10th Grade-leaving more room in schedules for exploration
- All students enter a Post- College and Career pathway- CTE is one of 3 options
- 45% of graduates attain an Industry Recognized Credential (IRC) or experience an apprenticeship by 2031-NEED value added
- Robust College and Career Exploration starting in middle school- more students will know the CTE pathway that makes sense for them

- Will offer a virtual information session for parents in the Spring

Career Coaches in each middle school (new this year)

Develop career plans through selfexploration, information sessions, guest speakers, field trips

### Post-College and Career Pathways

Goal: All students graduate completing one of the following:

- ► CTE Pathway
- ► AP Pathway
- ► Early College and/or Dual Enrollment



#### Middle School Pilot Program

- Introduction to Engineering Design and Exploring Computer Science
- Allow for more room in students' schedule when in high school
- Earlier exploration for students prior to entering a Post-College and Career pathway
- Will expand to all middle schools next year

#### Robust Career Exploration Program

- ➤ SY 23-24: Working with Tri-County Council and the College of Southern Maryland to enhance the scope and sequence for 6th through 12th grade students
  - ► Goal: Every student has an individual career plan that is updated yearly
  - ► Goal: Students make choices in high school that directly connect to their personal interests and strengths
