NAMING OF BUILDINGS, FIELDS OR SPECIFIC FACILITIES

The Region 10 Board of Education will determine whether or not a specific facility, field or building is of sufficient nature to be assigned a name. Any requests for naming of such areas submitted by a community member or staff will be reviewed by the Board of Education. The Board of Education has sole jurisdiction in determining whether or not to proceed with naming of facility, field or building.

The decision of the Board to name after a person will be based on assessment of the special significance of the name, or in the case of an individual, exceptional service to the children of Region 10 or to the state or nation. If a field or specific facility is named for an individual, it should be representative of a curricular discipline and the person's contribution to that discipline. Such recognition requires substantial support and comprehensive review.

Once an individual has been recognized in this manner, it will be the policy of the Board of Education not to rename an area, except under circumstances where substantial evidence is provided that would indicate that such recognition is no longer appropriate.
