SCHOOL DISTRICT LINES

The Board of Education accepts its responsibility for establishing attendance zones in such a way as to facilitate the educational program. Advance planning for new sites and buildings will be guided by the following criteria in determining school district lines:

- 1. Educational needs of the students
- 2. Proximity of students to school.
- 3. Safety of students
- 4. Ages of students serve
- 5. Nature and location of the appropriate educational program.
- 6. Racial/ethnic balance

Elementary School Assignment **Exceptions**: The determination of an exception to the elementary school (Lake Garda or Harwinton Consolidated) which a child is to attend will be made by the Superintendent of Schools.

Consideration will be given to such factors as location of residence, available transportation and class size.
