STANDARD OF CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

- 1. The driver is at all times in full charge of the bus and all students riding therein. He/she is required to enforce all rules and regulations adopted by the school authorities for the conduct of pupils riding on the bus.
- 2. Conduct on the bus must be consistent with Regional School District 10 Policies regarding Bullying and Harassment.
- 3. Wait for bus well back from the road, remaining until bus comes to a complete stop before moving.
- 4. In going to and from bus, look both ways and cross in front of bus keeping in sight of the driver.
- 5. Students must take a seat when they enter the bus and remain seated while the bus is in motion.
- 6. File on and off bus in an orderly manner, with no rushing or pushing.
- 7. Windows are to be regulated under the supervision of the driver. Under no conditions are children allowed to have their arms or hands out of the windows.
- 8. Distractions to the driver such as shouting and whistling are to be avoided.
- 9. Be on best behavior at all times. Horseplay or fighting will not be tolerated.
- 10. Hazard creating articles such as water pistols, knives, etc. are not to be carried on the bus.
- 11. No indecent or profane language shall be permitted on the bus.
- 12. Possession or use of drugs and/or drug paraphernalia and alcohol is prohibited.
- 13. Smoking is prohibited.
- 14. Students must not throw wastepaper, hats, books, lunches, or other articles while on the bus or near the bus.
- 15. Students shall assist in keeping the bus clean, sanitary and orderly and shall refrain from damaging or abusing the bus, its cushions or its equipment.

- 16. No student shall leave the bus without permission of the driver or school authorities except at student's home or at the school.
- 17. Students shall enter or leave the bus only at the front door except in cases of emergency.
- 18. Students shall be on time, and at all times cooperate in keeping the bus on schedule.
- 19. Students are to know emergency procedures.

Students violating these rules are to be reported by the driver to the school principal, who will, depending on the seriousness and/or frequency of the violations notify the parents as to the child's behavior.

If the violations continue, the student's riding privilege may be suspended by the principal for a period of time depending on the seriousness of the violations and the parents will be notified.
