Post-secondary Enrollment includes students who graduated with a regular high school diploma from a public high school in Illinois three years prior to the current school year and enrolled in a U.S. college within 12 or 16 months. The datasets used are the National Student Clearinghouse for higher education enrollment and ISBE's SIS for high school graduation.

AP Success Rate includes the number of AP exams taken and the number of exams passed at any point (score of 3 or higher) during high school, as well as the number of students who took at least one AP exam and the number of students who passed at least one AP exam. AP tests are scored on a 5-point scale.
