Let me end by expressing my gratitude to all the parishioners and the school parents of Sacred Heart. Thank you for your continued spirit of volunteering, faith, and financial support. As you will see from this report, last year was a fruitful time. I expect this coming year to be even better.



We would like to thank all the families and community businesses who participated in our 2022-2023 School Sponsorship Program. Thanks to your support, this program generated over \$71,000 for our school.

We kicked off our year of fundraising with “Fill the Heart” which supports the Sacred Heart School Annual Fund. The SHS Annual Fund is the cornerstone of our fundraising program. 100% of your gifts go directly to the school in support of vital programs, resources, and operational needs not covered by tuition.

In February 2023, our community gathered for the “Hearts in Havana” Auction Gala. Thanks to our incredible Auction Chairs, Kimberly Wylde and Jenny Wetzel, we had a record-breaking auction! 

