# DOMESTIC NONPROFIT CORPORATION ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR GETTYSBURG AREA EDUCATION FOUNDATION

In compliance with the requirements of the Nonprofit Corporation Law of 1988, 15 Pa.C.S.A. §5306 (relating to articles of incorporation), the undersigned, who is an individual of full age desiring to form a nonprofit corporation, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

# **ARTICLE ONE**

#### Name

The name of the Corporation is Gettysburg Area Education Foundation.

#### **ARTICLE TWO**

#### **Purpose**

- A. The specific primary purposes for which this Corporation is organized are to promote charitable, educational and athletic purposes and goals within the purview of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
- B. As a means of accomplishing the foregoing purposes, the Corporation shall have the following general purposes and powers:
- 1. To acquire any property, real, personal or mixed, or interests therein by grant, gift purchase, lease, devise, bequest or otherwise, and to own, hold, use, manage, sell, deal with, lease, pledge, mortgage, donate and dispose of the same in such manner, on such terms and for such considerations as the Board of Directors may determine subject to the provisions of the Nonprofit Corporation Law.

- 2. To invest and reinvest its funds in such mortgages, bonds, debentures, shares of preferred and common stock, and in such other securities and properties as its Board of Directors shall deem advisable, subject to the limitations and conditions contained in any gift, devise or bequest.
- 3. To borrow money and contract debts in connection with the acquisition of property or otherwise in aid of any of the purposes of the Corporation; and to dispose of its obligations for any amount so borrowed and to mortgage or pledge its property to secure the payment of such obligations, or of any debt contracted for such purposes.
- 4. To aid, support, advise and cooperate with educational corporations, associations, organizations, institutions or other agencies now or hereafter existing in carrying out the purposes herein specified, and to deliver over to them such financial resources, commodities and human services or property and to pay to them such amounts of its funds, both income as well as principal which the Corporation may deem proper.
- bereafter be conferred by law upon a corporation organized for the purposes hereinabove set forth, or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred, or conducive to the attainment of the purposes of the Corporation, subject to such limitations as are or may be prescribed by law; provided, however, that the Corporation may not exercise any power which would cause the Corporation to lose its tax exempt status. Provided further that the Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of the Corporation, as enumerated above.
- 6. The Corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise.

#### **ARTICLE THREE**

#### **Address**

The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is c/o Gettysburg Area School District, 900 Biglerville Road, Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, 17325.

# ARTICLE FOUR

#### Nonstock -

The Corporation is organized upon a nonstock basis.

# **ARTICLE FIVE**

## Membership

The Corporation shall have no members.

#### **ARTICLE SIX**

#### Restrictions

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its board members, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Two hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal

Revenue Law) of (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

## **ARTICLE SEVEN**

#### **Dissolution**

In the event of the dissolution of this Corporation, its assets shall be distributed to the Gettysburg Area School District, of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, or its successor, or to such tax exempt organizations that have similar purposes so that all assets of the Corporation shall be distributed exclusively to charitable organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. However, if the named recipient is not then in existence or no longer a qualified distributee, or unwilling or unable to accept the distribution, then the assets of this corporation/organization shall be distributed to a fund, foundation or corporation organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in Section 503(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

#### **ARTICLE EIGHT**

#### **Duration**

The period of duration of this Corporation is perpetual.
