6A. Updates

1. Track Modifications/Expansion at Buckeye School of the Arts and Shasta Lake School

Sean Hays presented the updated estimate for both projects. Buckeye School of the Arts is \$720,335.00 and Shasta Lake School is \$582,080.00. Photos of the tracks at Sequoia and Parsons were presented for reference. Sam Cassingham, Athletic Director for Shasta Lake School and Central Valley High School said an official track meet is held on an eight lane track. The estimate for an eight lane official track at Shasta Lake School would cost approximately \$1.2 million. The bid process and piggyback process were discussed by Sean. Maintenance & Operations should be able to absorb the extra costs outside of the bid. There is one-time RDA money that could be used also. Further questions need to be answered regarding the extra costs, so Sean is working with Hellas Construction to come to the next bond committee meeting and present the information regarding the projects and associated costs. The committee would also like information on the possibility to do an overlay on the existing track at BSA.

The cost to install the swimming pool at Foothill High School was \$7.2 million without locker rooms. This needs to be a city discussion with the school paying for the use for swimming. Discussion was had regarding a new school in 7-10 years in the Mountain Gate Meadows subdivision and the focus being on 20 acres of land with a modern K-8 school with a nice gym and full track. Athletics would be a feature for the school. Plans for the subdivision are currently not approved by the city, but the school district worked with the developer to pick a school site in their plans.

2. District Technology Purchases

Scott Sorrells provided the updated quote for the approved technology purchase on April 5, 2022. With the different monitors and revised quote, the cost is \$128,928.34. It is being presented for approval by the Board of Trustees on April 20, 2022.

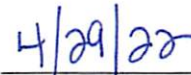

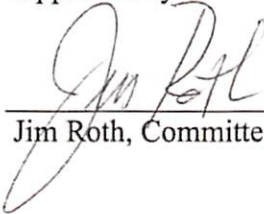

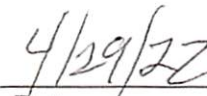
