Qualifications

General Requirements

- Must be at least 18-years old
- Must have 2-3 years of experience in the sport you're desiring to coach

- Ability to create a nurturing, loving environment where our student athletes can thrive

Core Characteristics

- Exhibit Biblical coaching - Coaching by the Power of God, according to the Word of God and for the Glory of God

Working Conditions & Physical Requirements

- Will stand and walk for extended periods of time
- Frequently communicates with students, parents and athletics department
- Majority of time may be spent outside resulting in exposure to extremes in either heat or cold as weather and temperatures vary.
- May occasionally have to lift up to 40-pounds
- Work is generally performed during the school year from 3pm to 6pm, but varies based on the sports schedules
