Dr. Patricia Sulak presented the curriculum Living Well Aware which is a curriculum for 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. The Living Well Aware 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum will be released in the spring. There was discussion among the SHAC members regarding the two different curriculum options.
