Goals for Parent 101



- Prepare for the high school transition
 - It's a BIG transition!
- Provide information that is relevant and prepares everyone for success
- Lots of different middle school experiences.
Past 3 years avg:
 - Approx. 35 different middle schools represented in each of the last 3 freshman classes
 - About 75% of 9th graders come from partner schools, 25% from outside the core partner school group

Student Scheduling Timeline

- Scheduling is open from February 1st - 23rd
- Students will be scheduled in their five required courses and allowed to select electives
- Recommended “Big 5” courses entered by February 14th. Can be changed until February 23rd by contacting Mrs. Johnson at bobbie.johnson@nicolet.us
- Students **MUST** use their Skyward login to select electives from a computer. Parent login information does not allow for course selection.

Student Scheduling Timeline

(continued)

- After February 24th - students and parents will be able to continue viewing their course selections but must contact Mrs. Johnson to make changes
- Schedule changes can be made after February 24th based on space and availability in those courses
- All changes must be finalized no later than June 7

Honors vs. Regular Coursework

- What's the difference?
 - Pace, amount of homework, reading level...
- Scheduling is based on a combination of:
 - Middle School Data and observations
 - Student and parent request
- GPA weight is the same

Freshmen Schedule

(what's included)

- Students take 7-8 credits each year
 - **Minimum of 7 required**
 - 7 = study hall both semesters
 - 7.5 = study hall one semester (randomly assigned)
 - 8 = no study hall
- The “Big Five” - English, Math, Global History, Biology and Health/PE
- Freshmen have a choice of up to 3 more credits



What's New at Nicolet High School?
Lots of exciting progress has been made over these past two weeks and we are excited for some big upcoming changes within the next few weeks!

Inside of the building, lots of progress has been made throughout the D-Wing Corridor. In-Dwelling bathrooms, framing walls, in-wall rough-ins, and wall blocking have all wrapped-up this week and we will soon be installing ceramic tile. In Dwelling Classrooms, we have been dropping ceiling tile and installing carpet! Soon we will be handing over the first phase of rooms!

Over at the Additions, we have been dropping ceiling tile, installing wall panels, and installing markerboards at the Band Addition. Next week we will be installing the flooring and metal panels! Over at the Tech Ed Addition, brick veneer and roofing are being installed and we recently poured part of the slab on grade. At the Infill Addition, we have been excavating and installing footings and foundations!

- Framing Walls in the D-Wing Bathrooms.
- Dropping Ceiling Tile and Installing Wall Panels at the Band Addition.
- Installing Brick Veneer and Roofing at the Tech Ed Addition.
- Excavating and Installation of Footings and Foundations at the Infill Addition.

Upcoming Work these Next 2 Weeks

- Installing Window Treatments at the Band Addition.
- Installing Windows and Metal Panels at the Tech Ed Addition.
- Backfilling Footings and Columns at the Infill Addition.
- Starting Demolition for the Next Set of D-Wing Classrooms.
