SETTING

Our facility is located outside Sonora at the Wade Outdoor Education Center and boasts over 140 acres of forests, streams, and trails in the Sierra Nevada foothills. In addition, we maintain a pool, astronomy tower, modern dorms, a full size dining hall, and a health office.

THE STAFF

Our staff consists of highly enthusiastic counselors, camp instructors, and program coordinators. Our counselors are college-age adults who have completed our JC program. The entire staff works to ensure that every camper can explore their imagination and creativity in a safe and friendly environment.

ACTIVITIES

Special camp activities vary according to the theme of the week. Campers also choose from other activities during the week, such as swimming, arts & crafts, creek explorations and other fun activities. Other special activities include campfires, staff hunt, sleepouts, and day trip to the lake, and all-camp games

REGISTRATION

This includes lodging, meals, activity instruction, themed adventures, and a camp T-shirt. Round trip transportation in Modesto and East Bay Area is available for an additional fee. Children registered for more than one week at a time, will be canceled from additional weeks*.
