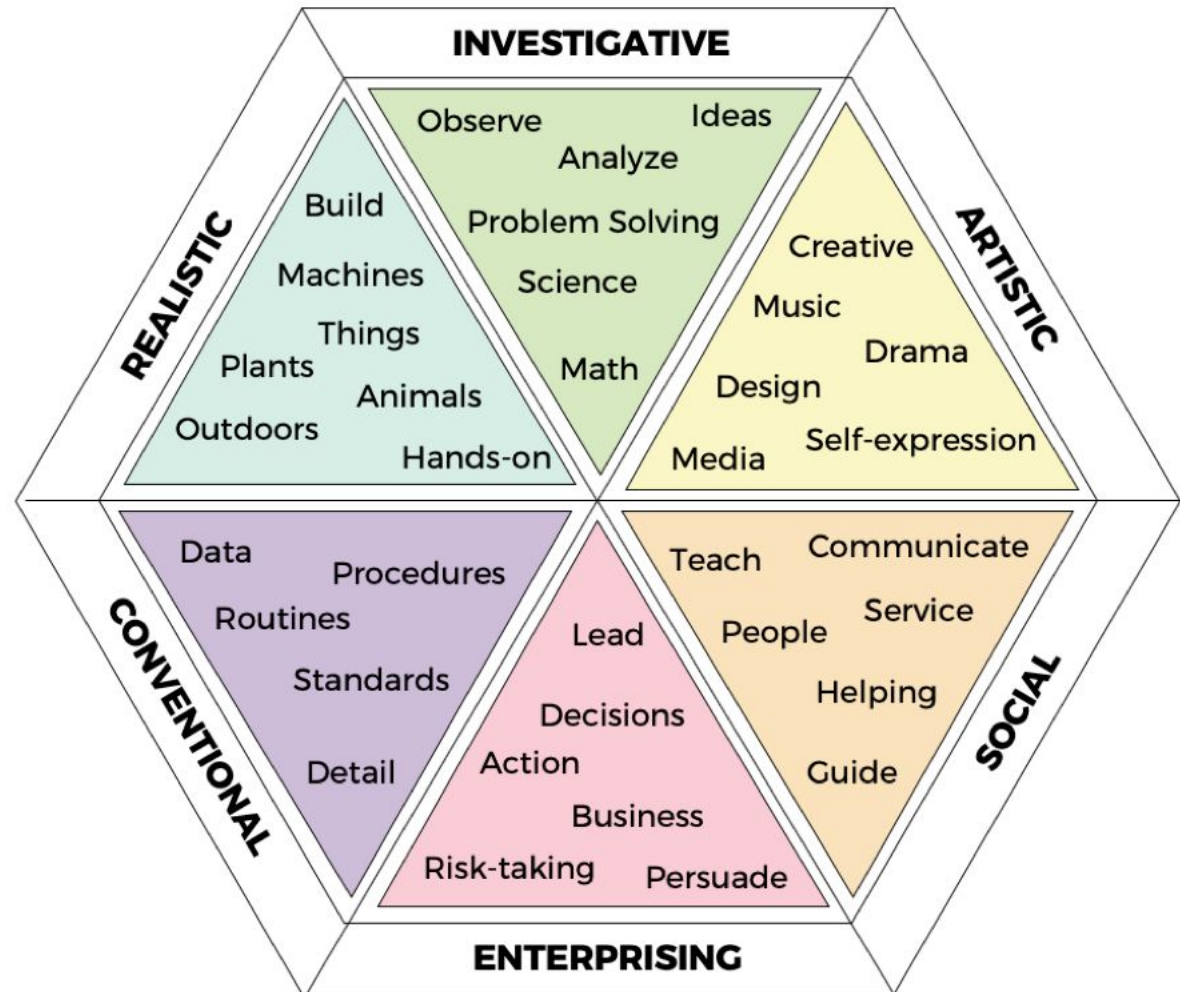

- SAT/ACT (early winter & again in spring) If needed
- Create a College List/summer preparation for senior year

- Meet High School graduation requirements (No SAT or ACT needed)
- Goal is to transfer to a 4-year college or earn a Certification/2-year Degree
 - ‘Counseling 5’ Course (State Requirement)
 - TAG, TAA and TAP Agreements (Transfer Admission Guarantee)
- Tips for Success:
 - Pick a Major during the first year of community college
 - Attend orientation/ Summer Bridge Program
