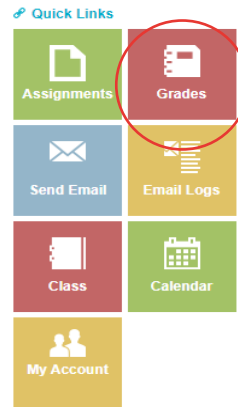

## Main Screen

To get back to the Main Screen, click Main on the light blue toolbar



The main page has three sections: 1) Quick Links, 2) Feed, and 3) Calendar

- 1) Quick Links take you to different parts of TeacherEase with one click (versus using the light blue toolbar)
- 2) The feed has notifications about assignments and more
- 3) Calendar has a list of upcoming assignments and due dates as teachers enter them
