

Frequently Asked Questions

Why is this project important?

The project is necessary to address repairs and renovations required by the New York State-mandated five year Building Conditions Survey (BCS), to upgrade our facilities to accommodate innovative educational programming and address building code issues. Renovating these scope items will extend the life of the district's building structures and improve the health and safety of our students on campus.

How is this project being funded?

Our district will receive 82.8% of project costs in aid from New York State on eligible project components. Utilizing the voterauthorized capital reserve (that was established to offset any local share of a future capital project) and this aid scenario allows for **NO ADDITIONAL TAX IMPACT**.

How will this project affect my child's school experience?

To fully prepare our students for the next generation of learning standards, it is imperative that we do so in an encouraging, engaging environment, one that sustains the integrity of our buildings and supports a plethora of diverse learning opportunities. Project improvements will bolster our students' educational, health, and safety needs with **NO ADDITIONAL TAX IMPACT** on the residents in our community.
