Dear families and staff of Parkway School:

Since our last communication about the water supply, we have made great progress towards having a safe and efficient filtration system at Parkway School.

We alerted you last month that we needed to extend the well house located behind the school to allow for larger filters. We want to update to you on the following:

- Our filtration system design has been reviewed and was found acceptable by the Connecticut Department of Public Health
- We have a Town of Greenwich Building Department permit for the pump house structure
- We have an agreement with [Wernert](#) building and construction managers to build the structure
- The proposals for the filtration system and design & installation have been accepted
- An overall project schedule is currently being devised, but we anticipate breaking ground around Thanksgiving Recess
- The Board of Education & BET have voted to provide additional funding to cover the installation of the filtration system; the RTM votes on Dec. 11; funding has been sought in coordination with design and emergency procurement, so it has not impacted the timeline

Parkway will continue to have a large supply of bottled water on hand for students and staff, while so many staff members and students bring their own filled water bottles to school each day.

Thank you for your continued support as we navigate this unanticipated challenge.
