It has come to our attention that there are some users of the car park who are behaving in a way that is potentially dangerous for children and families. We urge you to please use the car park with caution, and in particular:

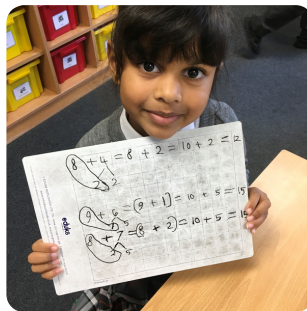
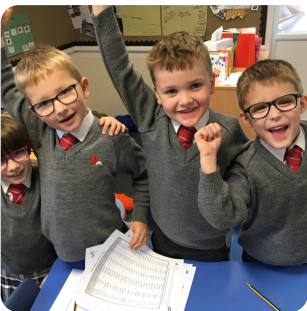
- Kill your speed, not a child.

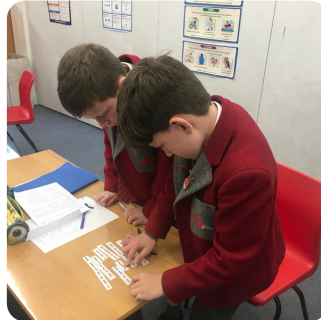
