





Students meeting state grade-level expectations.




#### **MATHEMATICS**

#### **School Goals**

Our school is committed to providing well-rounded learning experiences for each child and to making each child feel safe and connected to a caring adult while at school. We are always working on improving chronic non-attendance. Utilizing transformational social-emotional learning strategies through our Conscious Discipline initiative, we work on creating healthy learning environments that foster a climate of safety, caring and respect, and result in improved student academic outcomes.

#### **State Goals**

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% ontime, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.







#### BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

Our school has a CDS (Child Development Specialist) who visits every classroom every six days. He teaches lessons on socio-emotional needs, how to address bullying and harassment, conducting oneself with integrity and honesty, among many other topics. We have skills groups for students who are struggling (e.g., connecting with others appropriately, strategies for behaving appropriately on the bus, etc.), and we employ a number of strategies for connecting adults and students for positive reinforcement.
