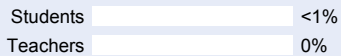

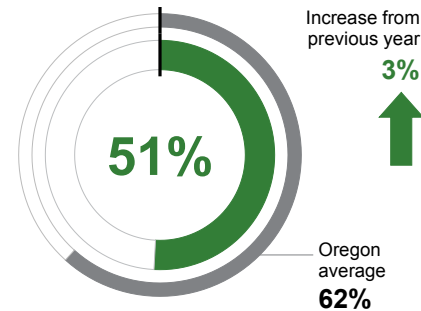
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

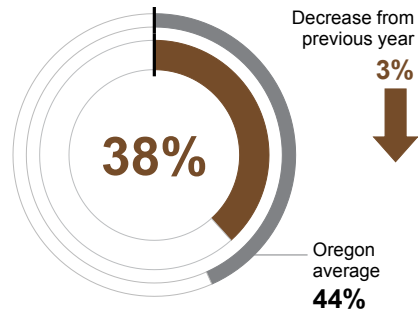
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

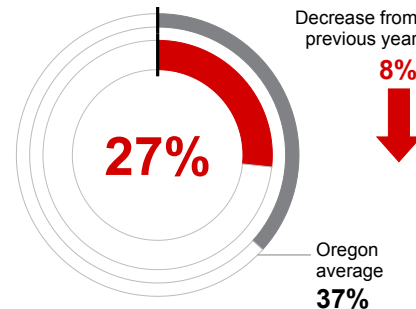
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



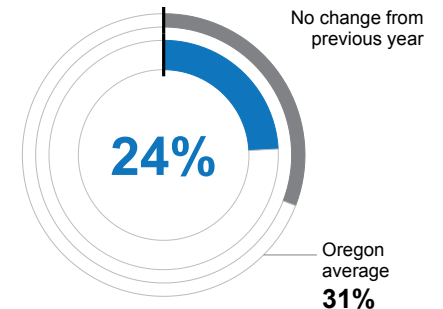
MATHEMATICS

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

Our school has a CDS (Child Development Specialist) who teaches lessons to every classroom every week. These lessons address socio-emotional needs, how to address bullying and harassment, conducting oneself with integrity and honesty, among many other topics. We organize skills groups to support growth in self-regulation and problem solving (e.g., connecting with others appropriately, strategies for behaving appropriately on the bus, etc.), and we employ a number of strategies for connecting adults and students for positive reinforcement.
