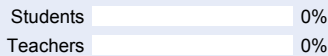

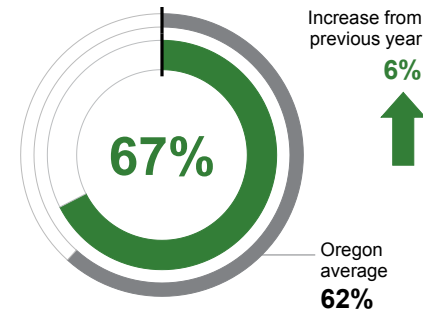
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

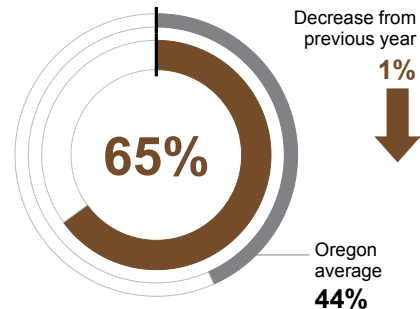
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

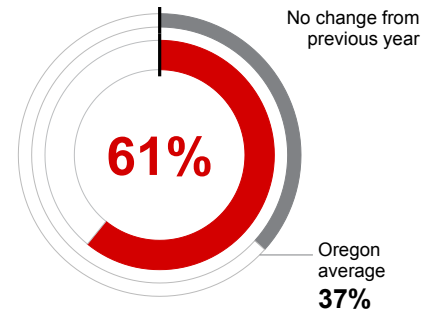
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



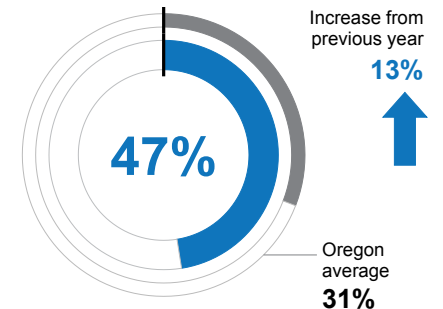
MATHEMATICS

Utilizing social-emotional learning strategies through Conscious Discipline, we will create healthy learning environments that foster a climate of safety, caring and respect, and result in improved student academic outcomes.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

We believe that behavior is best remediated through a restorative approach that ensures that they have not only made amends for their behavior but have also learned new skills to do better next time. Our teachers start each day with a morning meeting and greeting. BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

Our school has a CDS (Child Development Specialist) who visits every classroom each week. She teaches lessons on socio-emotional needs, how to address bullying and harassment, conducting oneself with integrity and honesty, among many other topics. In addition, we have a skills trainer who works in tandem with our CDS. Together, they plan and teach skills groups for students who are struggling (e.g., connecting with others appropriately, strategies for behaving appropriately on the bus, etc.). Our campus has gone through some renovation to create a safer space and to ensure that all members of our community first connect with the office when they enter onto campus.
