





Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2018-19 graduating in **2021-22**.




School Goals



REGULAR ATTENDERS




Academic Progress

Students earning a high school diploma or GED within five years. Cohort Includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2017-18 finishing in 2021-22.




State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% ontime, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment



ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Phoenix Charter School offers an Early College Program which provides students the opportunity to attend and earn dual credits at our local Umpqua Community College either online or directly on campus at the college.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Phoenix Charter School is directly partnered with our regional workforce board to provide the opportunity for direct case management and coaching for students nearing graduation to be hired by local employers by joining our EPIC (Employment Planning, Internships, & Coaching) program. Students can also be hired to join our resident Oregon Youth Corps programs and serve the community while gaining direct work experience during their school day. All students have the option of enrolling in a variety of CTE courses and work programs focused on: Food & Farm, Forestry & Natural Resources, Trades & Design, and/or Wellness & Resilience.
