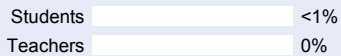

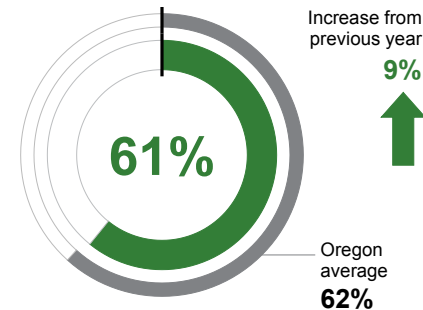
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

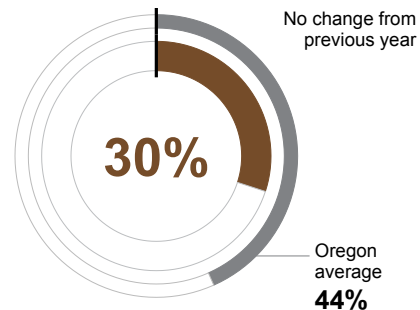
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

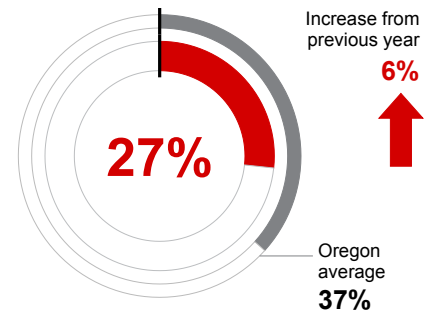
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



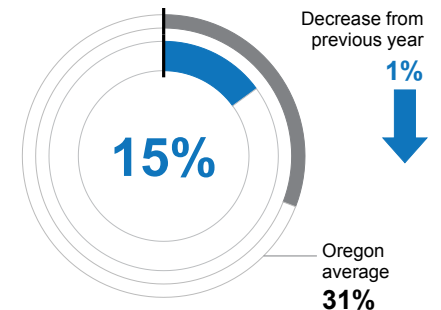
MATHEMATICS

School Goals

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

Sunnyslope has a Dynamic Behavior Support Team of professionals that work together to support students in the classroom and other areas of the building. This team includes a Child Development Specialist, TOSA and Skills trainer who visit classrooms repeatedly and work with all staff to weave a culture dedicated to providing equitable student experiences. We teach lessons on socio-emotional needs, how to address bullying and harassment, conduct oneself with integrity and honesty, among many other topics. Skill groups for students who are struggling (e.g., connecting with others appropriately, strategies for behaving appropriately on the bus, etc.), are used.
