KNOW WHEN IT'S TIME TO HAND OVER THE KEYS

Do you find yourself getting lost when driving, even if you've driven in the place before? Are you easily angered at other drivers? Is your car getting dents and dings? Are you having trouble staying in your lane or driving the correct speed? Are you missing stop signs or traffic lights? Are your loved ones worried about being in your car, or are they trying to get you to give up your license? These may be signs it's time for you to stop driving.

The National Institute of Health says that common health conditions and medication side effects may influence driving abilities. As you age, your joints may get stiff, and your muscles may weaken.

Arthritis, which is common among older adults, may affect your ability to drive. These changes can make it harder to turn your head to look back, turn the steering wheel quickly, or brake safely.

Eyesight and hearing are also big issues for those trying to determine if they are still capable of driving safely. Those 60 years of age and older should get a dilated eye exam every year or two.

If you think this might apply to you, talk to people who know your driving and listen to their concerns. You can also try an online assessment, such as this one from the National Highway Traffic and Safety Administration, to gauge your abilities: nhtsa.gov/older-drivers/driving-safely-while-aging-gracefully. (Kiplinger Retirement Report)
