This week students began their first Mission to Mars. In this experiment, students made scientific observations to compare two unknown substances. When these substances interact with water, they have opposite outcomes! One of the substances is hydrophobic and one is hydrophilic. Students practiced making scientific observations, recording data, and general lab procedures.

It's fun to see inquiry in action. Soon we are going to say "The Guppies Are Coming..." as we transition to Bottle Biology.
