ACT Voucher Details:

 All students are offered two free opportunities to take the ACT: second semester Junior year and first semester Senior year.

Additional Opportunities:

- Students that qualify for free and reduced lunch are eligible for **four** additional opportunities to take the ACT for free by way of vouchers. Two vouchers may be used <u>junior</u> year, and two vouchers may be used <u>senior</u> year.
- Vouchers must be used on national ACT test dates.
 Jefferson County High School is a testing site for <u>all</u> national test dates.
- Students that register for the ACT using a voucher will also receive free access to an ACT prep program through Kaplan.
- ★ If a student qualifies for free and reduced lunch, they can see their school counselor to receive a voucher.

New for the 2024-2025 FAFSA season seniors and their parents will need to create an FSAID prior to the opening of the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) which anticipated to open between mid-December - January 1. It can take up to 7-10 days for the FSAID to be verified so make sure you create your FSAID before FAFSA opens!



BLUEBERRY MUFFINS



Ingredients:

-1 cup Flour

-1 1/2 tsp. Baking Powder

-1/4 tsp. Salt

-2 Tbsp. Oil

-1/2 cup Milk

-1 Egg

-1/2 cup Blueberries or Chocolate Chips (optional) + 1 Tbsp. Flour



Recipe:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F.
- 2. Place 6 cupcake liners in muffin pan and spray with PAM.
- 3. Measure dry ingredients into a medium sized bowl. In a small bowl, crack one egg and beat slightly.
- 4. Add oil, sugar, and milk. Mix with a fork.
- 5. Add liquid ingredients to the dry and stir just until coated (12-15 strokes).
- 6. Add 1 T flour to blueberries or chocolate chips, then add to batter, and stir once to mix.
- 7. Put ½ cup batter into each muffin cup.
- 8. Bake for 15-18 minutes.

Ingredients:

-2 lbs Sausage (1 hot, 1 mild)

-12 eggs beaten

-1/2 milk

-2 cups Shredded Cheese

-1 cup crushed corn flakes cereal

-1 Stick Butter

-1 Can of Refrigerator Biscuits

-Salt & Pepper


Recipe:


- 1. Brown Sausage and drain fat.
- 2. Cut biscuits into ¼. Spread into greased casserole dish.
- 3. Top with cooked sausage, eggs, and cheese.
- 4. Top with cereal and butter.
- 5. Bake 40-50 min at 350 degrees.






