We are pleased to inform you that on Monday, December 11th, our 2nd grade students will be performing our School's Winter Concert. This concert will take place at the Poland Seminary High School Auditorium from 7:00 to 7:30 PM.

Students are encouraged to practice their music and any speaking parts at home! The students joined our Music Google Classroom during the past several weeks in their Technology class. Arrival:

Doors will open at 6:45 PM. Please park in the main parking lot and enter through Door D23. The doors are labeled for your convenience. Your child will report to the band room, where they will meet Miss Senatore, as well as their classroom teacher, and be organized by class. Family members and guests should report to the auditorium.

The concert will begin at 7:00 PM. We will take a brief moment to allow you to capture photos of your students on the stage before the concert begins. The children will be dismissed at 7:30 PM following the conclusion of the program.

Concert Dress:

We have several options for concert dress. Please make the choice that is best suited for your family and your situation. If there are any questions regarding concert attire, please reach out to Miss Senatore!

1. Second grade students are encouraged to wear red and green attire. Your child should be able to stand comfortably on stage in their concert attire for approximately 30 minutes. When choosing your child's outfit, consider that the stage temperature will be a bit warmer due to the stage lights.
2. You may also choose for your child to dress like one of the toys in our songs. We have the following toys in our songs: toy soldiers, princess dolls, puppets, teddy bears, and rag dolls. Dressing up like a toy is NOT required. Again, please be sure that they will be comfortable for the duration of the program.
3. If your child has a speaking role, you may choose to brainstorm and come up with a costume and/or small handheld prop that matches their role. For example, if your child is a "Blue Crayon," you may choose to have them wear blue or carry a crayon. If your child is a cowboy, they could wear a cowboy hat. Please let Miss Senatore know if you need help deciding on a costume idea, and please inform her of any ideas you have! Again, this is optional.
