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Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting – January 15, 2019 - 7:00 p.m.

Ambitious Instruction – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- ACCESS testing for K-8 English Learners will occur 1/23 2/26 to measure English language proficiency
- GM student course selection will begin 1/28 and is expected to include the same variety of courses offered this year. Advisory has been a valuable addition to GM for grades 5-8 and will continue in 2019-20
- Ongoing evaluation of the GM Foreign Language Program continues and indicates a high level of student proficiency (avg. grade is 83%) Details from teacher and student feedback will be reported in Feb/March
- The District's Annual Science Showcase (gr. 4-8) and STEM Challenge (gr. K-8) is scheduled for Feb 7th.
- Registration for our 2019 Camp Invention summer program for K-5 is now open Visit this <u>link</u> to register **Supportive Environment** The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.
 - Year to Date attendance rates (*Previous Year*): 96.2% (95.9%) for our 873 (889) students; 96.7% (96.9%) for our 80 (81) Certified Staff and 97.0% (96.3%) for our 61 (68) Non-Certified Staff. Goal = 97%+
 - 2nd Qtr discipline reports indicate that GW & GM are on-pace to reach year end school goals (<u>Appendix A</u>)
 - Required staff trainings (Anti-bullying, Violence Prevention, and Suicide Prevention) were held during Jan. faculty meetings and led by Gower staff members <u>Tip 62</u> is our anonymous bullying prevention link
 - Topics for survey-based paraprofessional training are set for 2/15 (Supporting Academic Achievement for Paraeducators) and 3/22 (Improving Behavior and Learning for Students with Autism Spectrum Disorders)
 - Facilities The GW Main Office Floor Project was completed over Winter Break along with an expansion of our school security camera system Current year expenditures are \$145,000 or 53% of allotted budget

Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.

- The Gower Foundation Speaker Series for February 12 will focus on the topic of Bullying in Schools
- Gower's first eLearning Day is Jan. 21st and is the make-up day for the Emergency Day used on Nov. 26th
- Gower entered the <u>Follett Challenge</u> to earn additional funds to update our library collections. Please vote for our entry using this <u>link</u> Voting takes place from Jan. 21-25; each email address may vote once per day

Collaborative Teachers & Staff – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.

- Grade Level and Teacher Teams have been working to prepare for the Jan. 21st e-Learning Day with e-Learning Modules made available to students on Jan. 18th Kudos to our staff for their work & support!
- The District Calendar Committee includes administrators, teachers and parents and will meet in late Jan./early Feb. to make a recommendation for the final 2019-20 calendar and a draft for 2020-21
- After-school committee meetings continue and most recently included Co-Teaching Collaboration Meeting, Tech Committee, and Innovate 62 in support of school/district improvement efforts
- In December, several teachers participated in a virtual professional development series called <u>Ditch Summit</u>
- Teachers and Support Staff will have the opportunity to participate directly in the Principal Eval process through an online survey tool targeting specific Professional Standards for Educational Leaders (PSEL)

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- The administrative review process of the curriculum design, organization of instruction, current class size and bell schedule is underway for 2019-20 staffing/program recommendations expected in Feb/March
- The District has been awarded the highest Financial Profile Designation with a perfect score of 4.0 After a short verification process, the 2019 Financial Profile will be posted on the IL State Board website (link)
- Two Gower Physical Education teachers, one at each building were recently approved by ISBE to teach Adaptive P.E. effective for the 2019-2020 as part of our overall special education program
- Gower Admin are coordinating a site visit later this month for a neighboring school district to learn more about our Middlebury Interactive Foreign Language Program at Gower Middle
- Gower e-Learning Day plans have been shared with a number of area districts for potential use/expansion
