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Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting - November 19, 2019 - 7:00 p.m.

Ambitious Instruction – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- The Illinois State Board of Education released 2018-19 School Report Cards here. Student IAR data is included along with new Summative (Tier) Designations. GW and GM are 'Commendable' (Appendix A)
- GM served as the host site for the annual <u>WSCAE Civic Action Weekend</u> in partnership with Northwestern University's Center for Talent Development on Nov 1-2. 100+ students from various districts participated
- Our Annual 8th grade Washington D.C. trip took place earlier this year (Oct. 11-13) with 54% overall student participation (41% last year). The D.C. trip is being planned for Oct. 9-11 for the class of 2021.
- Our 7th grade students participated in a <u>Science Behind Drugs</u> program on Nov. 8th and our 8th grade students participated in a <u>Teen Puberty/Health</u> program on Oct. 31st both led by Robert Crown
- The GW School Leadership team has updated the formatting of the K-4 Report Cards (<u>Appendix B</u>) Supportive Environment The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.
 - Year to Date attendance rates (*Previous Year*): 96.9% (96.7%) for our 882 (880) students; 98.3% (98.7%) for our 83 (80) Certified Staff and 98.6% (98.8%) for our 61 (62) Non-Certified Staff. Goal = 97%+
 - 1st Qtr Discipline Reports indicate a decrease in student referrals at GW & a decrease at GM compared to previous year; quarterly reports are used for annual reporting and trend analysis (<u>Appendix C</u>)
 - Required staff trainings in November (11th & 12th) were led by Gower staff members and included Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse Training for Mandated Reporters
- Facilities Update: Our architects (Green Associates) are reviewing the <u>2018 Facility Assessment Report</u> against preliminary <u>GW Campus Facility and Project Survey</u> data for early project scope and work design **Involved Families and Community** *Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.*
 - The annual <u>5-Essentials Survey</u> is open and we encourage all Gower parents to participate. Our standing goal is 35% parent participation and need your help to meet it! 32.3% last year; 24.4% GM, 40.1% GW
 - The Gower Foundation of Educational Excellence Speaker Series for 2019-20 continues on Dec. 10th with a screening of the documentary <u>Angst</u> (7 p.m. at GW) Visit the <u>Foundation website</u> for more information
 - The Annual PTO Holiday Bazaar at GW is scheduled for Dec. 6-7 Visit the <u>PTO website</u> to get involved
 - Parent Teacher Conferences will be held on Nov. 25th from 8am to 8pm. Students are not in session
 - Nov. 26th: eLearning Day (*Test Run*) Students are <u>not</u> in session. eLearning activities/assignments will be posted no later than 8:30 a.m. Teachers are "e" vailable for guidance and assistance from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm
 - Early results of the <u>GW Campus Facility and Project Survey</u> launched for parents indicate a higher priority for adding a STEAM Lab as well as a Full Size Gym for our K-4 students more details forthcoming

Collaborative Teachers & Staff – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.

- The Gower Education Association and the Board of Education have agreed to terms to amend and extend the <u>2018-2021 Collective Bargaining Agreement</u> and sign a 2021-2024 Collective Bargaining Agreement
- The PERA committee development an appeals process for unsatisfactory ratings in accordance with <u>Public Act 101-0591</u> The process is included in the revised Appraisal Plan posted on the district's <u>PERA webpage</u>
- Nov. 26th Teacher Institute Day eLearning training, engagement and collaboration, required trainings
- 2019-20 District Committee work continues and most recently involved our AT, PERA, ELA, ELL, and Innovate 62 Committees

Effective Leaders — School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- The ISBE eLearning Verification Formal shared with Regional Offices of Ed. is a replica of Gower's Model
- Gower's teaching staff continue to contribute to the profession through peer modeling/presentations and will be presenting at the state P.E. conference <u>IAHPERD</u> (Nov. 21-22) in St. Charles, IL
- Gower received grant approval for the following federal grant allotments to supplement our educational programs: <u>Title I</u> (\$70,116), <u>Title II</u> (\$17,580), <u>Title III</u> (\$17,170), and <u>Title IV</u> (\$10,000)
- Gower is approved to receive \$184,848 as part of the <u>IDEA PreK & Flow-Through Grant</u> Funds will be used for professional development, instructional materials, and to offset SpEd Staff salary
- The Principal Evaluation Model for 2019-2020 has been initiated and is based on 50% Professional Practice and 50% Student Growth (Appendix D)
