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## Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting - December 15, 2020 - 7:00 p.m.

**Ambitious Instruction** – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- Our Return to School Plan is the epitome of the 'Ambitious Instruction' category as our school community has engaged in simultaneous in-person and remote learning settings for our PK-8th students since Aug. 21st
- Our English Learner Program serves the individual needs of nearly 80 students that represent 32 different native languages spoken in Gower (Appendix A)
- Our 8th grade students participated in a Science Behind Drugs program on 11/20 and led by Candor Health
- Winter NWEA MAP testing, FastBridge Screening, and ACCESS testing are scheduled for Jan. 11-Feb. 12
- The District's Annual STEM Night is scheduled for Feb 11th as a virtual family STEM activity; the annual Science Showcase and Brookfield Zoo Science Fair will be postponed until the 2021-2022 school year

Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.

- Year to Date attendance rates (Previous Year): 96.1% (96.6%) for our 899 (885) students; 94.5% (96.5%) for our 88 (83) Certified Staff and 96.1% (97.4%) for our 50 (61) Non-Certified Staff. Goal = 97%+
- Required staff training on 12/8 and 12/9 was completed by school social workers on Mental Health Issue Identification and Course of Action
- On 11/24, staff participated in a training and survey regarding the Student Online Personal Protection Act (SOPPA), which goes into effect in July 2021; Board Policy 7:345 was adopted in Sept. 2020 as a result
- Facilities Update: An updated timeline has been shared with the Board of Education and is also posted on our Campus Projects & Referendum webpage - updates will continue to be posted throughout the project

Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.

- The annual <u>5-Essentials Survey</u> will open on Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup> and we encourage all Gower parents to participate. Our standing goal is 35% parent participation and need your help to meet it!
- The Gower PTO and Gower 62 ELL Team are co-sponsoring a multicultural cookbook to celebrate our diversity in place of this year's Multicultural Night. More details to come!
- The Gower Foundation continues to support our school community and is currently running a seasonal fundraiser to help support a variety of school programs
- With Winter Break upon us, please continue to do YOUR part so we can continue to do OUR part (Be sure to watch for more information regarding COVID-19 testing at our schools during the week of Dec 28th)

**Collaborative Teachers & Staff** – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.

- District Committee work continues and most recently involved our Physical Education, Tech Team, ELL, and K-8 English Language Arts teachers
- Our School Nurses have been instrumental in helping launch and sustain our voluntary, COVID-19 testing program which includes two forms of antigen tests, an antibody test and an at-home saliva-based PCR test
- Our GM P.E. Teachers are working on their **IAHPERD** Blue Ribbon application, which is due on Feb. 1st
- The District Calendar Committee has revised the 2020-2021 school calendar to include additional eLearning days on alternating Fridays between winter break and spring break
- Gower has been able to accommodate Hinsdale HS student interns & Elmhurst College practicum students Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.
  - Our on-site, COVID-19 testing program has been expanded to Gower Families through the use of an at-home saliva based PCR test, a second rapid antigen test (Abbott BinaxNow) has been added at no charge to the district - Further expansion is underway to include local police departments and Gower graduates
  - Gower administrators submitted the <u>Title III Language Instruction Educational Program Grant</u> which was subsequently approved by ISBE for an additional \$6,460 to support our English Learners
  - Gower administrators have applied for and have been accepted into a grant-funded microcredential program through the Illinois State University/BloomBoard partnership, Leadership for Equity/Certification Program
  - Gower administrators have recommended adding a section of 2<sup>nd</sup> grade to reduce the class size (from 25-27 to 20-21) to accommodate this grade level that has continued to grow since the beginning of the school year
  - Gower led a webinar hosted by the IL Assoc. of School Administrators on 12/7/20 to share our locally developed COVID-19 testing program to help other school districts interested in building one of their own
