## Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting - October 20, 2020 - 7:00 p.m.

**Ambitious Instruction** – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- Our <u>Return to School Plan</u> is the epitome of the 'Ambitious Instruction' category as our school community is engaging in simultaneous in-person and remote learning settings for students from Pre-K-8th grade
- The Illinois State Board of Education is expected to release the <u>IL School Report Card</u> on Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> which will not include 2019-20 IAR or other student performance data given COVID-19 cancellations last year
- 83% of our K students demonstrated '*Readiness*' in at least one of the three developmental areas in the 2019 screening of the <u>KIDS observation protocol</u> (77% previous year). Fall 2020 screenings are underway
- NWEA/MAP Beginning of Year benchmark testing in Reading and Math is complete for our K-8 students and the resulting data will be used to shape classroom instruction and student learning (Appendix A)
- Our 5<sup>th</sup> grade students and families participated in our annual <u>Health/Puberty Program</u> led by Candor Health Education (formally Robert Crown); held virtually this year on October 8<sup>th</sup>

**Supportive Environment** – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.

- Year to Date attendance rates (*Previous Year*): 98.0% (97.3%) for our 900 (881) students; 97.2% (98.5%) for our 83 (83) Certified Staff and 96.1% (99.4%) for our 56 (61) Non-Certified Staff. Goal = 97%+
- Student medical compliance is 97% (97%) at GW & 100% (100%) at GM prior to the 10/15 deadline
- Required staff trainings on October 6<sup>th</sup> were completed by school social workers on the following topics: Erin's Law, McKinney-Vento, Domestic & Sexual Violence
- The LED lighting project was completed across both campuses and yielded \$43,488 in ComEd energy savings rebates which was, in turn, used to purchase air purifiers for each of our classrooms
- Facilities Update: Revised drafts of the proposed addition at GW are available on our Campus Projects & Referendum page The \$14 million/zero tax rate increase question is on the Nov. 3<sup>rd</sup> ballot (Appendix B)

Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.

- The <u>Gower Foundation</u> hosted a <u>Superintendent Chat</u> on 10/15 to provide a 'community walkthrough' of the proposed GW addition proposal and Nov. 3<sup>rd</sup> Referendum Use <u>this link</u> to RSVP for future chats

- Gower PTO and Gower 62 are co-sponsoring a Northern Illinois Food Mobile Drive Thru at Gower West on Nov. 9<sup>th</sup> from 4:00-5:00 p.m. to help families in need Informational flyer will be coming soon!
- GW & GM parents are encouraged to use the <u>Parent Portal</u> to monitor student progress
- Virtual Parent Teacher Conferences will be held on Nov. 23<sup>rd</sup> from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Parents will be able to sign up through an online program, PickATime watch for more information to be shared by our schools

**Collaborative Teachers & Staff** – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.

- District Committee work is underway and most recently involved our PERA Committee, GM and GW Special Education Departments, ELL, Tech Team, and District Mentoring
- The <u>PERA Committee</u> met on 9/29 and established a <u>modified process</u> for the Teacher Appraisal System to be used in Gower for the 2020-21 school year due to the COVID-19 impact on teaching and learning
- Our October 13<sup>th</sup> Institute Days included Part 2 of the Nonviolent Crisis Intervention training, a Literacy training by the ELA Curriculum Committee for GW; and department meeting planning for instruction at GM; both schools using <u>Illinois Priority Standards</u> to guide their work
- The District Threat Assessment Committee will continue to learn more about mental health and trauma informed practices through a <u>DuPage NAMI</u> presentation (10/27) called *Ending the Silence*

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- The 2020-2021 District Budget was formally adopted by the Board of Education on September 22, 2020
- Gower was represented in the <u>Illinois Schools Step Up Webinar Series</u> for the IL Assoc. of School Leaders on Aug. 25<sup>th</sup> and is scheduled to be part of a <u>virtual panel</u> on Nov. 4<sup>th</sup> for the IL Assoc. of School Boards
- Gower's <u>Return to School webpage</u> continues to be a resource for other districts moving to an in-person learning model; of particular interest has been the self-certification card and completion of quarantine form
- The required plan for state and federal grant funding for 2020-21 was approved by ISBE and included improvement plans, a review of student data and needs, and alignment of grants to state and district goals
- Gower will receive \$98,523 for 2020-2021 in the ESEA as Amended Grant: Title I (\$71,416), Title II (\$17,107), and Title IV (\$10,000)
