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Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting — February 16, 2021 - 7:00 p.m.

Ambitious Instruction – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- Our Return to School Plan is the epitome of the 'Ambitious Instruction' category as our school community has engaged in simultaneous in-person and remote learning settings for our PK-8th students since Aug. 21st
- Mid-year NWEA MAP testing in Reading and Math is complete for students in grades K-8 and mid-year data across both subject areas indicate minimal learning loss - Reading: -2%; Math: -4% (Appendix A)
- GM student course selection will begin 2/17 and includes a number of scheduling adjustments aimed at maximizing student access and exploration of courses throughout middle school experience (Appendix B)
- 7th & 8th gr. students are receiving instruction in mental health and depression awareness through P.E. based on programming from Erika's Lighthouse and led by our P.E. staff, school counselor, and social worker
- 6th gr. students completed the Candor Ed. Life Begins program (2/11) as part of the Health Curriculum Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.
 - Year to Date attendance rates (Previous Year): 96.2% (95.8%) for our 901 (886) students; 94.7% (96.0%) for our 90 (84) Certified Staff and 92.5% (97.0%) for our 52 (62) Non-Certified Staff. Goal = 97%+
 - Required staff trainings held during February faculty meetings were focused on State Testing protocols, schedules and updates (the Illinois Assessment of Readiness; CogAT) and led by building principals
 - The 8th grade and High School Counselor visits were held remotely to build student schedules for 2021-22
 - Gower Cares continues for students, parents, and staff to identify student/family needs (additional support, clothing or school supply items from the Gower Cares Closet, recommendations for community resources)
 - Our on-site COVID-19 testing continues on Tuesdays (GW 4-6 pm) and Thursdays (GM 4-6 pm). Please continue to do YOUR part so we can do OUR part.
 - Facilities Update: School-based design teams have started the process of planning new/renovated spaces with our architects and the Campus Projects & Referendum webpage will be updated as progress is made

Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.

- The annual 5-Essentials Survey is open and we encourage all Gower parents to participate. Our standing goal is 35% parent participation and need your help to meet it!
- The Gower PTO and Gower 62 ELL Team are co-sponsoring a multicultural cookbook to celebrate our diversity; contributions for the cookbook are being accepted online through Feb. 12
- The Gower Foundation Parent Speaker Series included virtual screenings for the film Like on Feb. 11th
- Save the Date for our virtual Family STEM Night on February 25th at 7:00 pm; register HERE by 2/15.
- Our Feb. 12th Early Release schedule will allow GW Teachers to host parent conferences as-needed
- Collaborative Teachers & Staff The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.
 - District Committee work continues and most recently involved our Special Education teams, Tech Team, AT Committee, Mentoring, GM Exploratory, and GM STEM.
 - Feedback collected on the 2021-22 draft calendar has been positive. 63% of Gower Teachers surveyed (95%) response rate) support the change in school start times; final recommendation expected 3/16 (Appendix C)
 - The GM P.E. Team has applied for their 3rd consecutive <u>IAHPERD</u> Blue Ribbon of Excellence Award
 - Gower was awarded a Back to Books Grant (\$4,998.37) through the efforts of our District Librarian/Media Specialist-Funds will be used to purchase additional books for the GW book collection

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- Gower was involved in multiple collaborative vaccine efforts resulting in ~85% of our staff being vaccinated against COVID-19 (remaining staff have elected to schedule on their own or not receive at this time)
- Gower hosted a vaccine drive for 350+ Phase 1A and Phase 1B 65+ on Feb. 4th and coordinated a second drive for 320+ Phase 1B (School Staff) from across more than 20 school organizations (public and private)
- Gower Admin completed the EL Title III Intent to Apply application with local partners by Feb. 12
- A recommendation for 2021-2022 school registration and transportation fees has been provided to the Board for approval and includes a reduced rate in response to the COVID-19 pandemic (Appendix D)
- District administrators continue to review staffing plans for the 2021-22 school year with an ongoing commitment to maximize student supports - staffing plan is expected for the March Board Meeting
