## Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting - June 22, 2021 - 7:00 p.m.

**Ambitious Instruction** – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- Our End-of-Year (EOY) student performance data on NWEA/MAP indicates exceptional achievement levels despite the challenges of the 2020-21 school year. Typical growth goals were not met and will remain in place district-wide for the 2021-22 school year and to help set a post-pandemic benchmark (Appendix A)
- SB0654 (Student Play Time) requires 30 min. of play time in gr. K-5 and awaits the Governor's signature.
- SB 0818 (Sex Education) allows schools to adapt their local curriculum to meet the specific needs of their community. Gower Middle will continue to utilize Candor Health Education to provide the following programs: Teen Puberty (5<sup>th</sup>), Life Begins (6<sup>th</sup>), Science Behind Drugs (7<sup>th</sup>), and Teen Sexual Health (8<sup>th</sup>)
- HB0024 (Sexting) requires inclusion of age-appropriate discussion about sexting as part of a school's sex education curriculum (gr. 6-8).
- Gower Middle will continue the writing intervention program launched in 2020-21 for 5th-8th grade students as an additional student support and part of the overall Response to Intervention program.
- Summer Step Up, Extended School Year, STEM League, Jazz Band, Junior Jazz Band, Stitch Your Way, and Camp Invention are all underway on-site. Virtual 4th grade Band Camp, Art Challenge, and Virtual Art and

Nature are underway and provide additional learning opportunities for our students remotely.

Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachersas well as their peers.

- Year to Date attendance rates (Previous Year): 95.3% (Remote) for our 907 (892) students; 94.5% (Remote) for our 90 (84) Certified Staff and 93.4% (Remote) for our 51 (62) Non-Certified Staff. Goal = 97%+
- COVID-19 vaccine opportunities are available through DuPage County and other options for our 12-15 year olds and will be sure to share updates regarding eligibility for those under 12 when available
- Each of our school campuses are on schedule for full reopening for the 2021-22 school year on August 20<sup>th</sup> and our Admin. Team awaits updated <u>IDPH/ISBE</u> guidelines to address <u>Phase 5</u> of the <u>Restore IL Plan</u>
- In accordance with the Student Online Privacy Protection Act (effective July 1, 2021) parents can make student privacy related requests/inquiries by emailing <u>DataPrivacyOfficer@gower62.com</u>
- Our COVID-19 testing summer schedule is 8 a.m. 12 p.m. every Tues. & Thurs. at Gower West (Door #1) through July 1. Please park and come in! Tests are free and available to everyone in our community!
- Facilities Update: GM projects are underway and on-schedule and planning for our GW addition continues Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.
  - The preliminary 5-Essentials Survey Data indicates a 'well-organized' district and will be used to help set annual goals - ISBE is expected to release the participating school data here on June 30<sup>th</sup> (Appendix B)
  - Electronic registration for returning students is well underway for GW and GM through PowerSchool
  - Parents and families are encouraged to visit the Gower PTO and the Gower Foundation websites for updated information on ongoing activities/programs
- Plans for the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Orientation scheduled for Aug. 11<sup>th</sup> are underway (detailed information to follow) Collaborative Teachers & Staff – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.
  - District Committee work continues and most recently involved our Special Education Teams, ELA committees, Summer Step Up Planning, and PERA committees
  - The Parent Student Handbook Committee completed a draft for the 2021-22 Handbook (Appendix C)
  - The Professional Development Committee launched the Virtual Summer 2021 #Consider the 3PDs: Focus on Digital Learning Tools; Virtual Book Club, Fish in a Tree; & SMART and Google I & II Certification.
  - New Teacher Orientation is scheduled for Aug. 11-13 & Teacher Institute is scheduled for Aug. 17 & 18
  - The Gower Remote Educational Program Committee met June 16th to draft qualifications for short and long-term requests/needs, blended learning models (asynchronous and synchronous), and F.A.Q.s

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- The selection process to fill 2 of our 6 current teacher vacancies for 2021-22 continues (1 offer pending)
- The tentative 2021-22 school budget is scheduled for BOE review at the August 17th meeting
- Gower staff continue to work with representatives from the Burr Ridge Park District to ensure after-school options are available to Gower West families to support the new bell schedule (7:45 a.m. - 2:25 p.m.)
- District Federal Grant Plans for FY22 will be submitted by June 30<sup>th</sup> according to ISBE requirements
- Gower's Return to School approach for the 2020-21 school year was featured with Butler SD53 in the May 2021 School Business Affairs (SBA) ASBO International's monthly magazine
- Gower was a panelist for the statewide IDPH K-12 Testing Webinar held on June 10<sup>th</sup>
