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Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting — September 21, 2021 - 7:00 p.m.

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Ambitious Instruction – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- Our curriculum review cycle has been updated and reflects a rolling 5-year timeline (Appendix A)
- NWEA/MAP Beginning of Year benchmark testing in Reading and Math is complete for our K-8 students and the resulting data will be used to shape classroom instruction and student learning
- Individual student performance data in reading and math (NWEA/MAP, Fastbridge) and SEL data collected (SAEBRS) are being utilized as part of our school-basedMulti-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS)
- Newly adopted ELA curriculum (grades K-8) has been implemented on schedule with print and online materials available for various modes of instruction (in-person and short-term remote)
- The Math Interventionist, Math Specialist, and Primary Instructional Support Assistant are providing additional math support in classrooms and specific math interventions for students as needed
- Our <u>Remote Education Program</u>, designed around <u>Edmentum</u> and aligned to the same learning standards as our In-Person program, continues for the students approved for remote learning (GW 9; GM 5)

Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.

- Year to Date attendance rates: 95.9.% for our 538 GW students; 96.9% for our 378 GM students; 97.5% for our 92 Certified Staff and 97.1% for our 55 Non-Certified Staff. Goal = 97%+
- COVID-19 vaccines are encouraged and opportunities are available through <u>DuPage County</u> and <u>other options</u> for our 12-15 year olds and we will share updates regarding eligibility for those <12 when available
- Our <u>COVID-19 diagnostic and screening testing</u> efforts continue with daily on-site testing available to staff, students, parents, family and community members and serves as an important and proactive mitigation layer
- Required staff trainings in September were completed (9/14) by school nurses on the following health topics: asthma, diabetes, food allergy, anaphylactic shock guidelines, and COVID-19 updates
- Our anti-bullying efforts include an online reporting system <u>Tip 62</u> linked to school websites that allows for anonymous reporting (1 report was submitted in 2019-2020, 0 reports submitted in 2020-2021)
- <u>Facilities Update</u>: Referendum project planning is on-schedule with overall project budget being finalized **Involved Families and Community** *Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.*
 - Gower will host our 2nd annual Northern Illinois Food Bank Mobile Event on 9/30 from 4-5:30 pm at GW
 - Parents and families are encouraged to visit the <u>Gower PTO</u> and the <u>Gower Foundation</u> websites for updated information on ongoing activities/programs
 - The GW 4th grade team held a Family Trivia Night on 9/15 virtually on Facebook Live
 - Our annual Bring Your Parent to School Day at GW is postponed until further notice (GM tentative Jan. 28)
 - We encourage applicants for our remaining Education Support Personnel vacancies (Link to apply)

Collaborative Teachers & Staff – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.

- Newly adopted ELA curriculum (grades K-8) is being implemented with professional development during the August and October Institute Days to learn the various components of the new series.
- New teachers will participate in the Capturing Kids' Hearts Training on September 16 and 17 in Lombard
- District Committee work continues and most recently involved our GW ELL team, Technology, PERA Committee, GM FACS, and Special Education Teams.
- The District's <u>PERA Committee</u> will meet on September 21st to discuss updates and possible adjustments to the Professional Appraisal Plan based on <u>Public Act 102-0252</u> signed into law on Aug. 6th
- Our Early Dismissal/School Improvement Day on 9/24 is school-based and focused on beginning-of year student data review and support at GW and advisory program training (*Character Strong*) at GM

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- The final 2021-2022 District Budget is being submitted to the Board of Education for adoption
- Gower continues be a leader in on-site COVID-19 diagnostic testing and has <u>consistently advocated</u> for a <u>Test-to-Stay</u> approach as a modified quarantine which has finally been <u>approved for use</u> in DuPage County
- The current administrative framework utilized for student placement and class size meets our teaching and learning priorities and accounts for local and state budgetary guidelines (Appendix B)
- <u>ISBE Evidence Based Funding Calculations</u> indicate Gower's 'Percent of Adequacy' for student funding was 118% in FY22 resulting in \$599,290.32 of state funding for 2021-22 (FY21 funding was \$598,425.63)
- Our <u>IDEA Part B Consolidated Grant</u> was approved (\$179,619) to support our Early Childhood Program and our Special Needs (IEP) students to off-set program costs
- Our <u>American Rescue Plan (ESSER III) Grant</u> was approved (\$607,602) to address the impact of COVID-19 and help sustain the safe operation of schools
