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Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting - October 18, 2022 - 7:00 p.m.

Ambitious Instruction – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- NWEA/MAP Beginning of Year benchmark testing in Reading and Math is complete for our K-8 students and the resulting data will be used to shape classroom instruction and student learning (Appendix A)
- Individual student IAR (Spring 2022) and NWEA/MAP (Fall 2022) scores will be sent home on 10/21
- The Illinois State Board of Education is expected to release the IL School Report Card on Oct. 27th which will include 2022 IAR student performance data as well as a new data set on the Equity Journey Continuum
- K, 2nd, & 4th gr. students will receive instruction through the YWCA Child Assault Program (Oct. 11-14) to meet Erin's Law requirements. ECE, 1st, & 3rd gr. students are instructed by our Social Workers
- Our 5th grade students and families participated in our annual Health/Puberty Program led by Candor Health Education held virtually this year on October 6th

Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.

- Year to Date attendance: 94.0% (96.0%) for our 552 GW students; 96.2% (96.8%) for our 374 GM students; 95.2% (96.9%) for our 94 Certified Staff and 95.8% (96.8%) for our 59 Non-Certified Staff. Previous year data
- Required staff trainings in October were completed (10/18) by staff on Erin's Law, McKinney-Vento, Domestic and Sexual Violence; and Teen Dating Violence at GM
- Special Education Teams and related paraprofessionals received training on October 7 and 31 for Nonviolent Crisis Prevention led by trained Gower staff
- Student medical compliance is 96.7% (GW) & 98.0% (GM) prior to the 10/15 deadline (96.5%/97.0% in 2021)
- COVID-19 Community Levels are at Low Risk for DuPage County. Families are encouraged to cooperate with masking requests when notified of exposure. COVID-19 testing is available at both schools free of charge - Visit our COVID-19 information web page for more information
- Facilities Update: Visit our Campus Project website to track progress which is on-schedule for Spring 2023 Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.
 - Our annual Bring Your Parent to School Day at GW was held on Oct. 7th with over 382 parent visitors!
 - GM Invite Only Parent Teacher Conferences were held on Oct. 12th from 3:45-6:45 pm; GW and GM have Parent Teacher Conferences on Nov. 21st from 8 am to 8 pm - More details to follow from school principals
 - The Gower Foundation Gala held on Sept. 17th was a great success raising over \$40,000 for school projects!
 - Parents and families are encouraged to visit the Gower PTO and the Gower Foundation websites for updated information on ongoing activities/programs
 - GW & GM parents are encouraged to use the Parent Portal to monitor student progress
- **Collaborative Teachers & Staff** The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.
 - Gower West earned the Preschool for All Gold Rating again this year; and continues to meet the eligibility requirements for the ExceleRate Illinois Gold Circle of Quality
 - District Committee work continues and most recently involved our District ELL team, Social Studies, Science, Special Education Teams, District Mentoring, and K-4 Math
 - Our afternoon Professional Learning on 10/7 and 10/31 are school-based and focused on Using Data to Guide Instruction, Social Science Standards review, Standards Based Grading on 10/7, and the IL School Report Card and Curriculum Alignment work by departments/grade level teams on 10/31.
- Nov. 22: eLearning Day (Practice Run) Students are **not** in session. eLearning activities/assignments will be posted no later than 8:30 a.m. Teachers are "e"vailable for guidance and assistance from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.
 - The final 2022-23 District Budget was adopted by the Board of Ed. on 9/18 and posted on our website here
 - Gower will receive a total of \$110,916 for 2022-2023 in the ESEA as Amended Grant distributed as follows: Title I (\$82,104), Title II (\$18,812), and Title IV (\$10,000)
 - Our IDEA Part B Consolidated Grant was approved (\$189,883) to support our Early Childhood Program and our Special Needs (IEP) students to off-set program costs.
 - Gower schools will receive a final 'Summative Designation' on Oct 27th based on a number of Individual <u>Indicators</u> as part of the 2022 ISBE Report Card and the state's <u>Support and Accountability (ESSA) Plan</u>
 - The Principal Evaluation Model for 2022-2023 has been initiated and is based on 50% Professional Practice and 50% Student Growth (Appendix B)
