Ambitious Instruction – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- The required state assessments of <u>IAR</u> in grades 3-8) and ISA (5th and 8th grade) are planned for April; and students who qualify for the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) in grades 3-8) began testing on March 15
- Our Adaptive Physical Education and Peer Buddies program at Gower West will be featured in a video through Adaptability to showcase the program
- Our 4th Gr. students will participate in the presentation, <u>Substance Abuse Prevention</u> on 4/4 at GW. This content is in line with our inclusion of Illinois Instructional Mandates related to Health and Safety & Awareness. Participation is encouraged. Parent opt out is available upon request
- Registration for Gower Summer 2023 Offerings is now available register by 5/5 using this form Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.
 - Year to Date attendance rates: 92.0% for our 506 K-4 GW students; 94.7% for our 379 GM students; 94.4% for our 94 Certified Staff and 96.4% for our 58 Non-Certified Staff. Goal = 97%+

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- Gower is currently hosting two Speech and Language Pathologist Interns to expand our relationships with local universities and to recruit new professionals for an anticipated retirement in 2024
- The Preliminary Staffing Plan for the 2023-2024 school year has been submitted to the Board for review and will begin a formal review process with the Gower Education Association (Appendix A)
