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## Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting - April 25, 2023 - 7:00 p.m.

**Ambitious Instruction** – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- The required state assessments of IAR in grades 3-8 are complete results will be made available on the Illinois School Report Card when published in the Fall of 2023 and on our Academic Performance webpage
- Our K-4 Math Curriculum Committee recommends an upgraded curricular series (*Illustrative Mathematics* from Imagine Learning) to be implemented in the 2023-2024 school year (Appendix A)
- The WSCAE Art Expo is scheduled for 4/29 at the Cheney Mansion in Oak Park from 10 am to 2 pm
- K-8 NWEA End of Year MAP testing is scheduled for the week of May 8<sup>th</sup> with an End of Year NWEA MAP Board report is anticipated for the June 20<sup>th</sup> Board meeting
- Registration for Gower Summer 2023 Offerings is now available register by 5/5 using this form Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.

- Thank you for helping us exceed our standing goal of 35% parent participation on the annual 5-Essentials Survey! It was a record setting year with a 46% overall parent response rate! (52% GW, 37% GM)
- 2023-2024 school year registration for returning students is underway As of today, we have 64 Kindergarten students registered for next year! Welcome Gladiators!
- The final preschool screening for 2022-23 was held on 4/20 Screening for next year will resume in August
- The Spring Musical is scheduled for April 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> at Gower Middle; Our 4<sup>th</sup> grade students will travel to see the show during the school day on April 27<sup>th</sup> as one of our transition activities for our rising 5<sup>th</sup> gr. class

- District Committee work continues and most recently involved our Special Education Teams, K-8 Science, Professional Development, and K-4 Math
- 4/7 Early Release Day was school-based and focused on progress towards school improvement goals. The 4/10 Institute Day was focused on curriculum work and an Illinois Resource Center workshop on Culturally & Linguistically Responsive Practice for Any Classroom
- The Parent/Student Handbook Committee will meet on 5/2 to begin the process of reviewing, revising, and updating the 2023-2024 handbook; the draft will be presented to the Board at the June meeting
- GEA Leadership has reviewed the Preliminary Staffing Plan presented in March and supports the updates noting the importance of continuing to explore effective models/strategies for early primary support (PK-2)
