- Develop financial literacy
- Understand the process of preparing for college or technical school
- Experience the value of reflection through conversation in small groups with a focus on one's personal journey and the tools needed to navigate life
- Receive mentoring by PBC Staff to help plan for life beyond graduation, including college essay/application assistance and career planning support
