Discussion items:

1. The minutes from the September Community Council meeting were read. Shannon Davenport motioned to approve the minutes. Kaylee England second it. It was voted to approve the minutes.
2. Tara Nichol will serve as a parent member on the Community Council.
3. Feedback was provided by Principal Rhees from Sunset regarding the new school boundary information. Some students from Sunset will be relocated to Doxey. There are many families worried about the relocation. We would like to have a community celebration to welcome the new boundary students to our school. We are looking into Spring 2024.
4. A reduced school speed zone was discussed. We are looking into a study to be completed.
5. Doxey will be conducting a school walk through for the community in the fall and Spring. The first walkthrough will be held on Tuesday, October 24, 2023, at 9:15 am. This is a wonderful way for people interested in serving on the Community Council to see what our school is all about. We will be giving a tour of classrooms and other areas of our school.
6. We reviewed High Reliability School (HRS). This is a framework for school improvement that requires survey data for feedback. We use a validated survey tool that is credible and reliable for data collection to provide us with information to help our school improve. It is a great tool for gathering stakeholder perspectives. There will be a link in the newsletter to fill out the survey. Gift card drawings will be used to encourage and promote participation. The first survey is Safe and Collaborative Culture.
7. School data was reviewed for the 2022-2023 school year end of level RISE assessment. Grades 3 through 6 take the RISE assessment. We are using structured literacy interventions and Deep Data Dives with educators to improve proficiency. Acadience reading data was also reviewed. Students K through 6 are assessed by Acadience. The Acadience reading results for our school showed 62% proficiency in reading at the end of last school year.
8. Feedback was provided about Doxey Spirit Night. Students and families loved it! The scavenger hunt was a success.
9. Community council parents appreciated the efforts being made at crosswalks to keep their students safe.
10. Next Community Council meeting was scheduled for November 14, 2023, at 4:30 pm.
