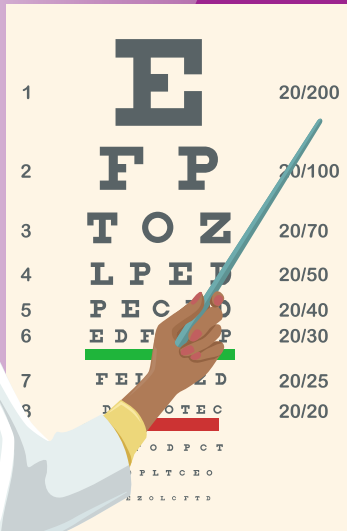


VISION COVERAGE



Know Before You Go:

To get an idea of how much your cost will be before you schedule your visit, simply log in to your member web account and click "Estimate Costs".

Annual Eye Exams keep your eyes healthy. Serious conditions such as Diabetes, Hypertension, and Multiple Sclerosis can be diagnosed through an eye exam.

Premium Contact Lens Fit and Follow-Up	10% off retail price
Frames (once every calendar year)	\$0 copay; \$130 allowance, 20% off balance over \$130

Single, Bifocal, Trifocal, Lenticular	\$0 copay
Standard Progressive	\$65
Premium Progressive	\$65, 80% of charge less \$120 allowance
UV Coating, Tint (<i>Solid and Gradient</i>) and Standard Scratch-Resistance	\$0
Standard Polycarbonate (no charge for under 19 years old)	\$40
Standard Anti-Reflective Coating	\$45
Other Add-Ons and Services	20% off retail price
Contact Lenses (Contact lens allowance includes materials only)	
Conventional	\$0 copay; \$130 allowance, 15% off balance over \$130
Disposable	\$0 copay; \$130 allowance, plus balance over \$130
