#### December 13th at 6:00 p.m. - PTA Book Study


We had our first PTA Book Study session this week and will be sharing our takeaways with you and encouraging you to join the next session.

#### April 13th from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.






Want to learn a new language and meet friends who share your interests? Join our brand new American Sign Language Club!


