

2020-2021 COLLEGE NOW ENROLLMENT GUIDE FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

JCCC's College Now program provides high school students with an opportunity to earn college credit through concurrent enrollment while completing their high school requirements.

- 1. APPLY** for admission only one time regardless of how many semesters you take classes at JCCC. Go to **admissions.jccc.edu** to start your application.

For new students, to ensure your eligibility to enroll before the deadline, apply no later than the priority date listed on the calendar in this publication. When your application is processed, you will receive an email that includes your JCCC ID number and login information.

- 2. TEST** or place into your College Now courses, if applicable (ex., English, math, science, CNA, etc.).

To determine if a placement test is required for your course, go to **jccc.edu/collegenow** and click the Class Schedules link to look up available courses for your high school. If a prerequisite or test score is required for your class, it will be noted.

To assist students during the COVID-19 pandemic, our faculty has created several pathways for students who need to enroll in courses that have a placement test requirement. For information on how to meet the placement requirement for your College Now course, go to **jccc.edu/collegenow** and select Testing Information from the left sidebar.

- 3. ENROLL** in classes online or by phone. For enrollment deadline dates, see the calendar in this publication.

– To enroll online, first go to **jccc.edu/collegenow** and click the Class Schedules link to look up the courses available at your high school. Write down the five-digit CRN numbers of the courses you plan to take.

– Log in to MyJCCC and click the green Add/Drop Classes button. Select the term “Credit Fall” for fall semester or yearlong courses or “Credit Spring” for spring semester courses.

– Select the **Enter CRNs** tab on the top left, enter the five-digit CRN numbers for your courses, click Add, then click Agree & Submit.

– Confirm that your courses show a status of “Registered” to ensure your enrollment was successful.

- 4. PAY** tuition at the time of enrollment. Tuition may be paid online by logging in to MyJCCC and selecting the My Finances tab. No payments can be accepted by phone. Students are financially responsible for all charges on their account.

FALL 2020 SEMESTER AND YEARLONG COURSES

August 2020

- 1 Fall College Now class schedules are available online at jccc.edu/collegenow
- 24 Fall College Now enrollment opens

September

- 25 Application priority submission deadline* (select summer/fall 2020 admission term)
ACT test score priority submission deadline, if applicable

October

- 12 Deadline to complete placement testing or request a placement waiver
- 16 Last day to enroll in a College Now fall semester or yearlong course
- 19 Last day to drop a College Now fall semester course and receive 100% refund

November

- 2 Last day to drop a College Now yearlong course and receive 100% refund
- 16 Last day to request pass/fail grade option or to withdraw with a "W" for a College Now fall semester course
- 16 Last day to drop a College Now yearlong course without a withdrawal "W" on the student's permanent record

March 2021

- 1 Last day to request pass/fail grade option or to withdraw with a "W" for a College Now yearlong course

December 2020

- 1 Spring College Now class schedules are available online at jccc.edu/collegenow

January 2021

- 19 Spring College Now enrollment opens

February

- 1 Application priority submission deadline* (select spring 2021 admission term)
ACT test score priority submission deadline, if applicable
- 12 Last day to enroll in a College Now spring semester course
- 15 Last day to drop a College Now spring semester course and receive 100% refund

April

- 15 Last day to request pass/fail grade option or to withdraw with a "W" for a College Now spring semester course

**Forms will be accepted after the priority deadline; however, admissions cannot guarantee they will be processed before the enrollment deadline.*

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

If you need to drop your College Now course, it is your responsibility to drop the course online or complete a schedule change form at JCCC. If you drop the course at your high school and do not drop the course at JCCC by the deadlines listed here, you will receive a failing grade on your academic record.
