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## Program Eligibility

**WHO** High school students who are in an approved concurrent credit class and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

**WHAT** University credit earned concurrently through Baker University (upon completion of course with a grade of C or higher).

**WHERE** These courses are taught by high school staff on the high school campus during regular school hours.

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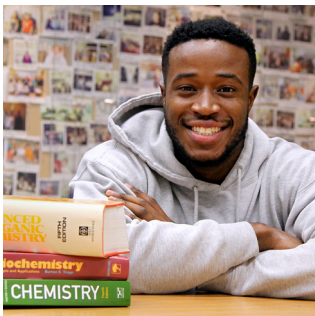

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## Enrollment Process

- Enroll online at [bakerU.edu/concurrent-credit](http://bakerU.edu/concurrent-credit)
- Click the Enroll Online button.
- Fill out the form and submit payment
- Tuition is \$110 per university credit hour. Pay via credit card online, or use the alternative form for check or money order.



## General Guidelines

Each CCP student pays a reduced rate of \$110 per credit hour. A typical 3-hour course costs \$330. Some of the courses are 4 credit hours.
