

JCCC Checklist for High School Seniors

Follow these steps to complete your enrollment process!!

1. Apply for Admission OR if you are already a JCCC student change status to "Degree Seeking."	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go to: www.jccc.edu/admissions. When your application is processed, you will receive an email that includes your JCCC ID number and login information. If you took classes at JCCC in high school, you MUST change your status to "Degree Seeking." 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Apply: No later than Mid July after graduation Change to Degree Seeking: Spring of Senior Year
2. Apply for Financial Aid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Apply for Financial Aid online at www.fafsa.gov. Log in to your MyJCCC student account to view your financial aid status and complete financial aid requirements displayed. If your financial aid file is complete by July 1 your accepted financial aid will protect your enrollment until funds are available Apply for JCCC scholarships at www.jccc.edu/scholarships 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> FAFSA Priority Deadline for JCCC is March 15th JCCC's Scholarship Deadline is April 1st
3. Attend an Orientation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Orientations are done in the Student Success Center or online. For more information on orientation go to: http://www.jccc.edu/admissions/orientation/index.html. No sign-up required! Orientation must be completed before you will be allowed to enroll in classes for the Fall term. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spring of Senior Year
4. Complete Placement Testing or Submit qualifying ACT scores	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Placement testing or submission of qualifying ACT scores is required for some courses at JCCC. Visit www.jccc.edu/testing for more information and for study guides. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spring of Senior Year
5. Meet with a Counselor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A counselor can provide assistance with academic advising, transfer information, personal or career counseling, and disability accommodations. 6. Enroll in Classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You can enroll in classes online by logging in to your MyJCCC account. Enrollment for the Fall term are usually mid to late April. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mid-April to August
7. Pay Tuition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tuition may be paid online or in person at the Bursar Office. Students will be dropped from their classes for nonpayment. For more information about paying tuition, go to www.jccc.edu/admissions/tuition. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mid-August for Fall Term
