12th Grade: Feb. 1

Complete the FAFSA and apply for financial aid and scholarships at your community college.

10th - 12th Grade

Apply and be admitted to your local community college. Complete approximately 30 college credits from dual credit/concurrent enrollment and/or AP/IB courses in high school. Register for Degree in 3 as early as the April of your sophomore year and no later than the December of your senior year. Meet with your high school counselor and the Degree in 3 Coordinator regularly. Attend extracurricular events at KU Edwards Campus.

8th - 10th Grade

Develop your academic plan with your high school counselor. Consider selecting up to 30 college credits from the dual credit/concurrent enrollment and/or AP/IB courses offered through your high school.
